**TJ** Valle won the 2022 Cashion Fishing Rods AOY race at Keuka Lake, September 11th. TJ took the 1st Place prize with 15.87 lbs.

From the Desk of **Wes Vyverberg**, **Tournament Director**.

TJ "Livewells and Kill Switches" Valle widens the gap with 15.87 lbs. for the win at the Mixer, all but closing it out for the 3-peat and picking up a \$125 Shimano First Place Cash. Some say he's "enfuego" or he's on fire, others say it's the all-composite construction of the diamond v hull that allows him to compete at such a high level.

**Liam Blake** climbs into second place, 21 points (16.55 lbs.) off the lead, with a solid 4th place finish.

Four points back sitting 3rd in the AOY race we have "bent" Rod Brown, who picked up the \$200 Striker Big Fish Cash with a 4.61 lb. lunker smallmouth.

Congratulations to new non-boater *Hunter Stone* on his second-place finish with a 15.68 lbs. bag from the back deck of the diamond V. Hunter boy picks up \$75 Shimano Cash and some dock cred to boot. Oh, and let's not forget the impromptu *Tradewins Googan Award* for the smallest limit

HUNTER STONE 2nd Place - 15.68 lbs. which goes to **David Holtby** with an impressive 5-fish satchel weighing in at just 6.06 lbs. and boasting a 1.212 average, not an easy feat to beat.

Taking 1st Place was **TJ Valle** with 15.87 lbs.

TJ said; "I practiced a couple days and I found my fish to be holding in fairly shallow water in and about 20-22 feet.

I caught all of the on 3/4 oz. football jig. All the fish I caught were smallmouth.

I had approximately 6 areas and I kept rotating through them and weeding through fish to get to my weight. I did catch about 40 fish on the day."

In 2nd Place was **Hunter Stone** with 15.68 lbs.

Hunter said; "I caught most of my fish on a football jig on deep flats along with fan casting a small swimbait and slowly retrieving it along the bottom. Most of my bites came first thing in the morning."


Finishing in 3rd Place was **Matt Ferrante**.

Matt said; "I fished small points where there was deep water throwing an a-rig. I caught 8 fish, all smallmouth. My biggest fish came on my last cast by the launch which helped cull out one of my two dinks.

**Liam Blake** took the 4th Place spot with 14.78 lbs.

Liamsaid; "My partner Jake Zaremski and I fished 2 areas all day making long drifts in 22-32 feet of water. Having a number of dropshots on the deck with varying leader lengths from 3 inches to 3 feet was key to making fish commit to the bait based on weather conditions and where they were set up in the water column.

Jake and I had a great day catching fish from start to finish. Thanks to Steve and the weighin crew for having



the scales set up when everyone arrived back at the dock."

3rd Place - 15.00 lbs.

5th Place went to Dave Livingston with 14.76 lbs.

Dave said; "Keuka was definitely different this year. Only certain areas were holding fish. With no specific depth, this suggested they were on the move.

As always weather also played a big part, and tournament day was somewhat different than practice.

### **DAN VYVERBERG** 7th Place - 13.79 LBS.

The smallmouth were moving around and the largemouth were hunkering down. If there was a dock bite, it eluded me.

I lost two good fish first thing, so my mood matched the weather. I only had 4 fish by 1:00 PM, and two of them were small.

After a pleasant talk with the officers on the Sheriff's boat, and positive safety inspection (no tickets), the day got better. I found one spot in shallow (5-6') that was concentrating fish, and I was able to catch several there that made a big difference. Surprised that they had moved shallow here (both smallmouth and largemouth), but they were definitely feeding.

All in all it was a tough day and Keuka is hard to figure out. A beautiful lake but a real challenge for fishing. Can't wait to come back (sarchasm. Sheldon)!

My fish were all caught (or lost) on a NED rig, dropshot, wacky Senko or craw tube. G-Loomis rods and Diawa and Shimano reels."

Rounding out the Top Seven, **Dan** Vyverberg with 13.79 lbs.

Dan said, "The weather did a complete 180 on game day. It was a grinder kind of day...I had 3 fish in


